During the open house, information will be presented about the purpose and goals of the plan, the county's existing transportation system, and the schedule for completion of the plan. Staff will also be available to discuss the plan and answer questions. (There will not be a formal presentation.)

Attendees will be asked to identify issues, concerns, and priorities for investment related to the county transportation system. Information collected at the meetings will assist in the development of potential solutions and/or areas for additional study.

The plan will address a range of transportation modes including the county highway network, general transit opportunities, trails, freight infrastructure, and rail within the county. The final plan is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2018, and will reflect the issues, needs, and priorities identified by users of the county transportation system.
