

Internship Opportunities

Sherburne County Health and Human Services offers a variety of internship opportunities in a range of educational levels across a number of fields of study for students to enhance their academic learning with real world experiences. Internships at Sherburne County typically follow an interview process. Through internship placements, students receive valuable training while providing valuable public service to the community.

Typically, internship opportunities at Sherburne County HHS are unpaid. Internship offers are made based on the candidate's skills, interests and abilities, and the needs of the Sherburne County HHS Department. Sherburne County cannot guarantee placement in an internship.

Internship opportunities include individuals who are providing work without pay for which they typically earn credit at a vocational school or program, college or university. A criminal background check may be required for some placements.
