

## **SECTION 14.0:**

### **MASS BURN AND RDF INCINERATION**

Subsection 1. State Rule Adopted. Incinerator facilities shall meet all of the requirements of Minnesota Statutes and Agency Rules, Chapters 7001 and 7035, which are hereby adopted by reference as part of this ordinance.

Subsection 2. All incinerators shall be designed and operated in a manner to conform to emission limitations of Federal, State and Local air pollution control regulations.

Subsection 3. Applicability. This section shall apply to all persons seeking a permit to construct or operate a waste incinerator for financial remuneration with a capacity of 350 pounds or less per hour that is planned to manage waste not generated by the owner or operator of the incinerator. This section also applies to existing and new incinerators having a capacity greater than 350 pounds per hour. Incinerator facilities must adhere to Minnesota Statute 116.801, if applicable.

Subsection 4. Permit and License Requirements. The applicant shall submit a complete set of plans, specifications and reports prepared by a Registered Professional Engineer under the laws of the State of Minnesota. It is unlawful to operate a Mass burn or RDF facility without a license from the County Board. Said license shall meet all requirements of Section 5 of this ordinance.
