1. Welcome: Dawn Nyhus welcomed the group and J. welcomed Commissioner Danielowski. Board member introductions were completed. Motion to approve agenda was made by Mary Jo and seconded by J.
2. Domestic Violence Caseload/New PO: New Probation Officer, Anita Burke was hired in February. She comes with experience in high risk supervision of adult offenders. Department now has two Probation Officers (Denita Bogart and Anita Burke) assigned to specialized domestic violence caseloads. They are working on building relationships within the community and looking at resources to assist/support victims. J. thanked Teresa for her

input/participation during interviews. J. discussed Community Coordinated Response (CCR) facilitated by Rivers of Hope. Teresa said they had about 30 participants in day long virtual training to learn about the Duluth Model regarding domestic abuse prevention. Those in attendance included Law Enforcement, HHS, Mental Health providers, school representatives and Community Corrections. The goal of the program is to build relationships and coordinated response to domestic violence.

3. CSTS Portal: J. provided brief overview of project coordinated with STI (vendor), Anoka, Stearns and Sherburne County. Portal allows for two-way communication between POs and offenders. It also allows the offender to update their contact information and view their conditions/progress. Nicole provided demo of how the PO will use the Portal and how the offender will use the Portal. Judge Yunker requested information be sent out.
4. Future Discussion Topics: J. requested to let him know if you would ever like additional information/presentation on any topics. Judge Yunker would like additional information on the interception between Community Corrections and mental health programming through the jail and HHS. Amanda discussed Mental Health Action Team (MAT) initiative and crossover between HHS, Community Corrections and the jail. Amanda will present on this topic at next meeting. As we head toward post-COVID operations, Judge Yunker is interested to hear what members/departments are anticipating and how they are planning to make the transition. Are there any challenges with planning for post-COVID operations?
5. Opioid Litigation: Kathy said Sherburne County has been invited to provide feedback regarding resources to potentially be distributed to communities. Kathy invited HHS, Sheriff's Department and Community Corrections to the Attorney General listening session. She will bring additional information to the next meeting. This is advance planning for opioid litigation resolution.
