

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-016

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CERTAIN ACTIVITY RELATING TO SHERBURNE COUNTY HIGHWAYS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS; REQUIRING PERMITS AND THE PAYMENT OF SERVICE FEES FOR CARRYING ON SAID ACTIVITIES; AND ESTABLISHING A REASONABLE FEE SCHEDULE FOR SAID PERMITS AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE SHERBURNE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

The Sherburne County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

Section 1. Driveways (ingress/egress)

- a. No driveway abutting upon a county highway shall be constructed, relocated, or reconstructed without first obtaining a permit from the Sherburne County Highway Department and the paying of an appropriate fee, as set forth under Section 4 of this ordinance.
- b. A performance bond of \$75.00 must be posted prior to the commencement of any work in connection with an above required permit.
- c. Construction in connection with an above required permit shall conform with all requirements stated in the permit and of the Sherburne County Highway Department.
- d. The cost of delivery of any culvert required as a part of any construction in connection with an above required permit shall be \$35.00.

Section 2. Building or Structure Moving Permit

- a. No building or structure may be moved upon, across, or along any county highway without first obtaining a permit from the Sherburne County Highway Department and paying of an appropriate fee, as set forth under Section 4 of this ordinance.
- b. The permittee under this section shall hold Sherburne County harmless and pay for any damage caused to the County or any third party as a result of the movement of any building or structure upon, across or along any county highway.
- c. The provisions of this section do not apply to any Sherburne County road-building or maintenance equipment.

Section 3. Utility Permit

- a. No utility lines, subways, canals, or conduits shall be constructed within the right-of-way of any Sherburne County highway without first obtaining a permit from the Sherburne County Highway Department and paying an appropriate fee, as set for under Section 4 of this ordinance.
- b. Utilities include, but are not limited to: telephone, electric, natural gas, television cables, city water and sewer lines.
- c. Construction in connection with an above required permit shall conform with all the requirements stated in the permit and of the Sherburne County Highway Department.

Section 4. Fee Schedule

Driveway Entrance Permits

Private Driveways	\$ 35.00
Commercial Driveways	\$ 75.00
Entrance Bond	\$ 75.00
Culvert Delivery	\$ 35.00

Moving Permits

Annual Moving Permits	\$100.00
Building Moving - per move	\$ 20.00

Utility Permits \$ 20.00
or \$.01 per foot whichever is greater.


Section 5. Penalty
