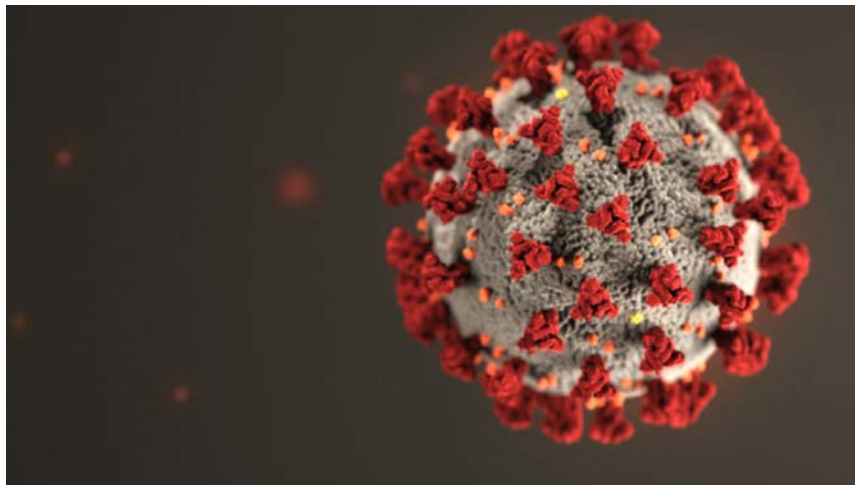

Minnesota COVID-19 Action Team



The Minnesota COVID-19 Action Team urges the public to remain vigilant for fraud schemes and other unlawful activity, including:

- Price-gouging/hoarding of medical supplies essential goods
- Schemes targeting economic impact payments (i.e., stimulus checks)
- Sales of fake testing kits, treatments, or cures for COVID-19
- Solicitation of donations to illegitimate or nonexistent COVID-19 charities
- Fraudulent phone calls from individuals posing as health insurers seeking personal information
- Phishing emails from entities posing as the CDC or WHO, which may contain malware
- Websites claiming to provide stimulus funds, asking consumers to input their bank information
- Fraudulent medical billing for procedures related to COVID-19
- Threats to public officials who advocate for quarantines
- Threats to intentionally infect law enforcement or others with COVID-19
- Hate crimes or bias-motivated harassment
