COVID-19 HEALTH SCREENING

In compliance with MDH and CDC guidelines, Sherburne County is screening members of the public who are requesting services that require close contact with employees for signs of COVID-19. In order to receive the services you are requesting, you are required to review a set of health screening questions and your temperature may be taken.

Your response to the health screening will NOT be collected, recorded or retained by the County. The screening is only administered to ensure that it is safe for County employees to have close contact with you for the services you are requesting or are required to participate in. You are NOT required to participate in the health screening, but your failure or refusal to do so will result in you being denied the services requested or required.

If you indicate that you are experiencing the symptoms identified in the screening or if you have a temperature or otherwise display symptoms of illness, County staff may refuse to provide services and you will need to reschedule.
