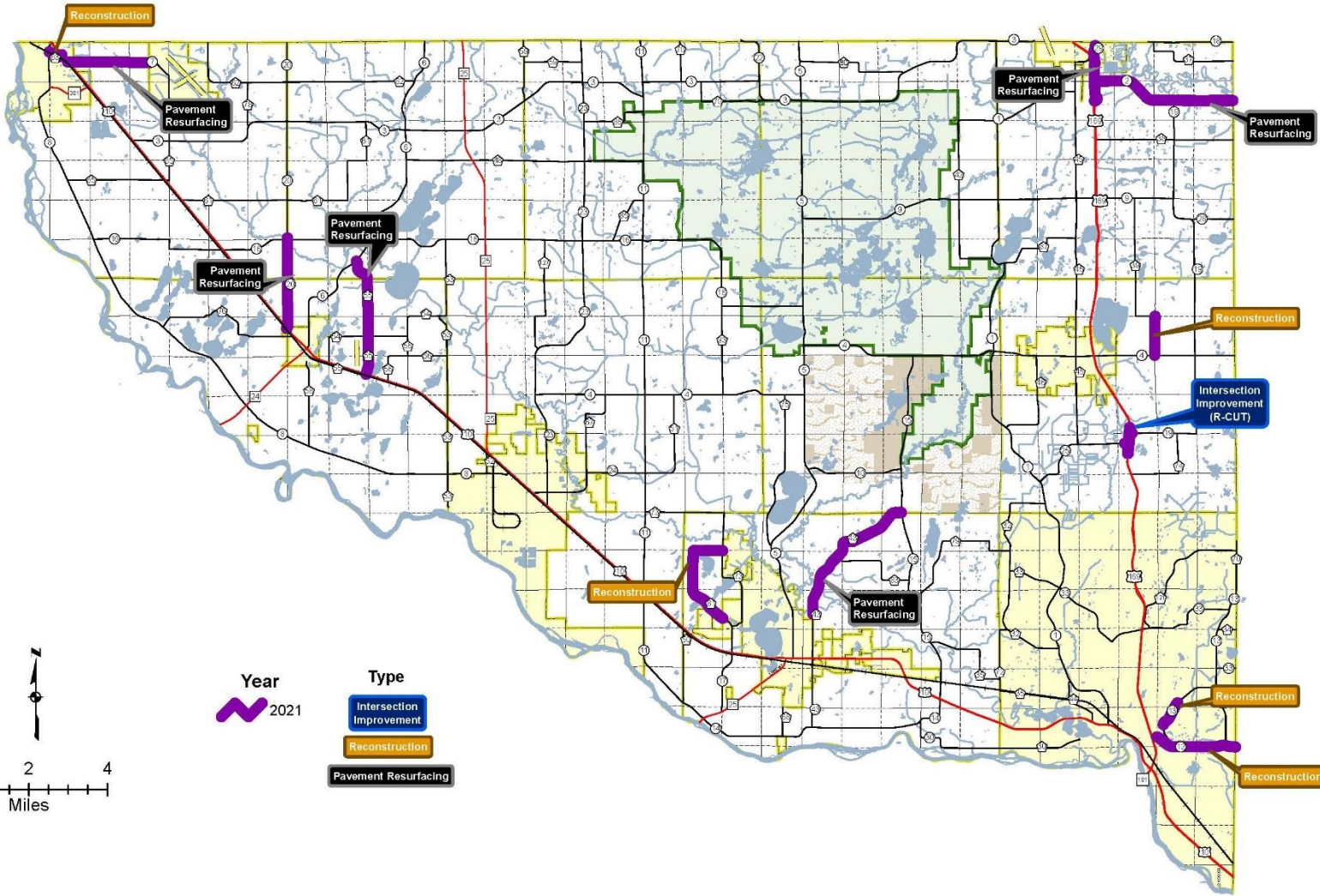




# 2021 Construction Program

Sherburne County will again have a busy construction year. We anticipate the construction season will begin mid-April and continue through the end of October. The 2021 construction projects are shown on the map below:



## Elk River Area

County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 12 from Line Avenue to the east County Line

This is a reconstruction project that is carrying over from 2020. We anticipate construction will be completed by the end of June of this year.

CSAH 13 from Line Avenue to Tyler Street

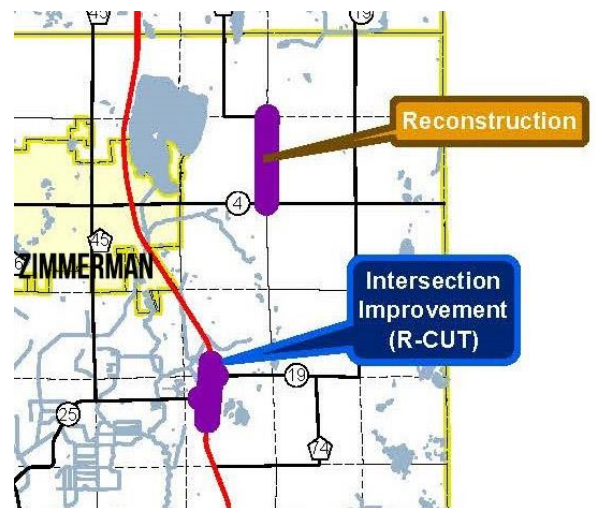
This is a reconstruction project that will accommodate 2-12' driving lane, and continuous left turn lane and two roundabouts. One roundabout will be constructed at Line Avenue and the other at Tyler Street. CSAH 13 will be closed and detoured for the duration of the project. Construction is anticipated to begin in July and be completed by the end of October.



## Livonia Township Area

Hwy 169, CSAH 19, and CSAH 25 Intersection Improvement – Restricted Crossing U-Turn (R-CUT)

This project will construction an R-CUT to eliminate left turns onto Hwy 169 from CSAH 19 and CSAH 25. To make a left turn onto Hwy 169, vehicles will need to make a right turn onto Hwy 169 then a perform a U-Turn to get back onto Hwy 169. The R-CUT improves safety by reducing the number of points where vehicles cross paths. Construction is anticipated to begin in June and be completed by August.



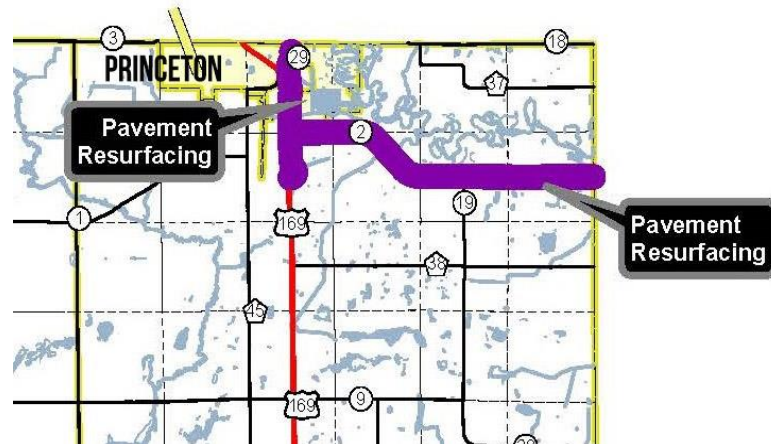
County Road (CR) 39 from CSAH 4 to 269<sup>th</sup> Avenue

This is a reconstruction project that will accommodate 2-12' driving lanes with 6' paved shoulders. CR 39 will be closed and detoured for the duration of the project. Construction is scheduled to begin the first week of June and be completed by the end of July.

## Princeton Area

CSAH 2 along Hwy 169 and out to the East County Line

This is a pavement surface improvement. Work will consist of removing or reclaiming the existing pavement and placing a new paved surface. Work will mostly be confined to the existing surface. However, there will be some areas where minor in-slope work be performed. Construction is anticipated during the month of August.



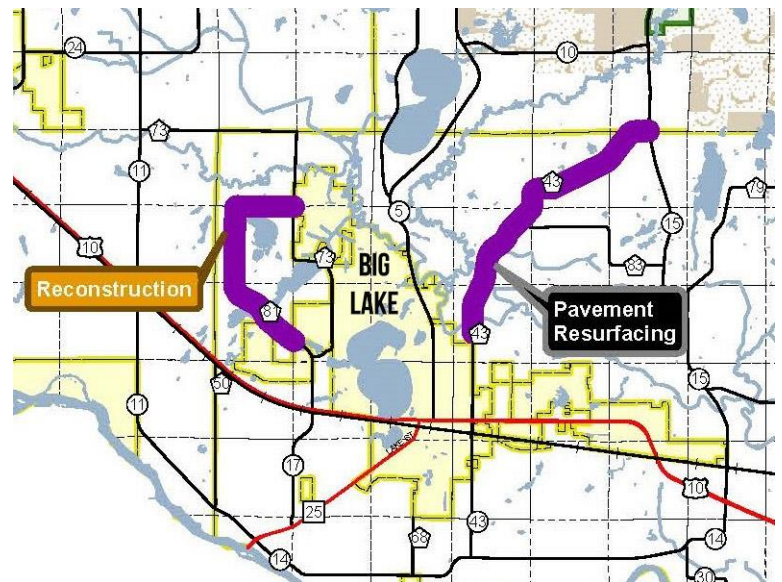
## Big Lake Area

CR 43 from the Elk River Bridge to CSAH 15

This is a pavement surface improvement. Work will consist of removing the existing pavement and placing a new paved surface. Work will be confined to the existing surface. Construction is scheduled for the month of July.

CR 81 from Lake Ridge Drive to CR 73

This is a reconstruction project that will accommodate 2-12' driving lanes with 4' paved shoulders. CR 81 will be closed and detoured for the duration of the project. Construction is scheduled to begin this fall with work being performed off the existing road. The reconstruction of CR 81 be performed during the 2021 construction season. Work performed this fall will not require road closures and detours.



## Clear Lake/St. Cloud area

### CR 55 from Hwy 10 to CSAH 6

This is a pavement surface improvement. Work will consist of reclaiming the existing pavement and placing a new paved surface. Work will be confined to the existing surface. Construction is scheduled to begin the first week of July and be completed by the end of August.

### CSAH 20 from Hwy 10 to CSAH 16

This is a pavement surface improvement which will improve the strength of the road. Work will consist of removing the existing pavement and excavating the class 5 and subgrade. New class 5 and pavement will be placed to increase the strength of the road. CSAH 20 will be closed and detoured for the duration of the project. Construction is scheduled to begin the end of May and be completed by the first week of July.

### CSAH 7 from Hwy 10 to East of 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue

This is a pavement surface improvement. Work will consist of removing the existing pavement and placing a new paved surface. Work will be confined to the existing surface. Construction is scheduled to begin the first week of July and be completed by the end of August.

### CR 63 from CSAH 8 to the Park-n-Ride

This is a reconstruction project that will accommodate 2-12' driving lanes and a sidewalk. CR 63 will be closed and detoured for the duration of the project. Construction is anticipated for this fall.
