



Sherburne County Parks and Recreation System Plan

Sherburne County's park system consists of four natural-resource based parks and one future park, and one corridor trail (see map bottom right). The County is in the beginning stages of developing a plan for the next 10-20 years of its Parks and Recreation System. The planning process will run through December 2022, and will include several opportunities for community engagement. The County is interested in hearing about your experiences with the park system, identifying where there are issues and concerns today, and understanding what desires people have for future investments.

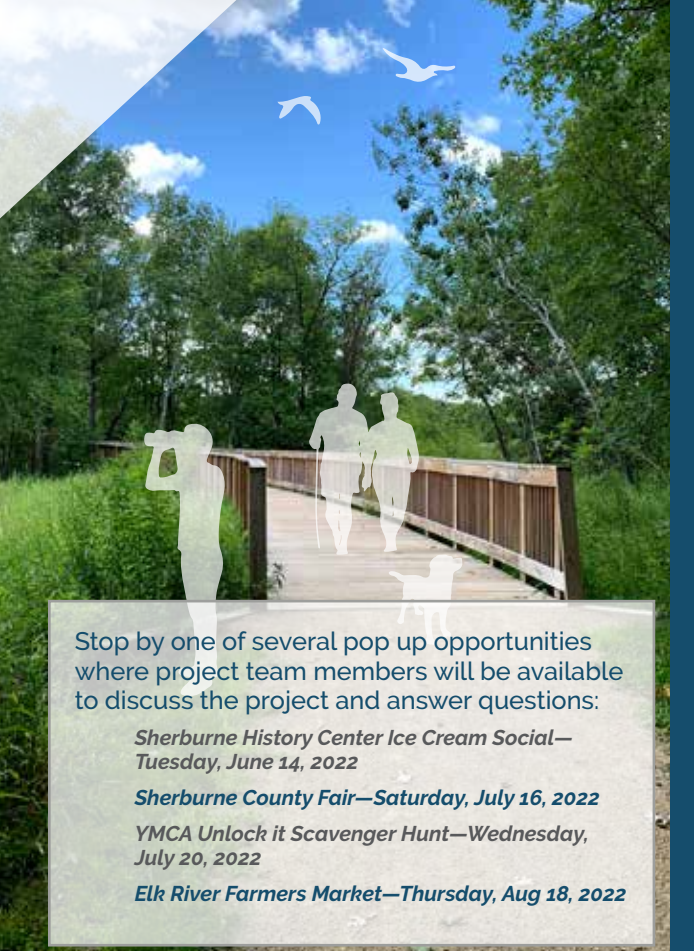
